The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.37 dated 28.02.2019, under Sections 147, 148, 149, 323, 365, 379-B, 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Loharu, District Bhiwani, Haryana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that allegations against the petitioner in FIR are that he alongwith co-accused had abducted complainant who had alleged that he was beaten up by them. However, no injury was found in the MLR of the petitioner. The FIR was also registered after 8 days of the alleged abduction and the complainant is stated to have been released within an hour of the occurrence of the abduction. The petitioner is in custody for over 2 months and 17 days and is not involved in any other case.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from S.I. Ram Niwas, states that challan has been presented before the trial Court but charges are yet to be framed.

Heard

In view of the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioner, especially, when the investigation has been completed and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
