Report dated 30.10.2018 of learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ludhiana has been received after recording statements of accused Naveen Attri, Renu Attri, Akshar Sharma and Mamta Sharma as well as complainant Aarti Sharma alias Ashima Attri and the learned court has shown its satisfaction that the compromise is an outcome of voluntariness, free will and without any coercion or undue pressure. In the light of the satisfaction shown by the Court and in view of the fact that it is a pure matrimonial dispute and

compromise will go a long way in ironing out the differences and for betterment of their future life and in view of the law laid down in **Gian Singh vs State of Punjab and another, 2012 (4) RCR (Criminal) 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs State of Punjab and another, 2007(3) RCR (Criminal) 1052** and in view of which the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No. 48 dated 3.6.2017 under sections 406, 498-A, 354, 354-D, 420, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Women, Ludhiana and all consequences arising thereof are quashed, qua the present petitioners.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
