This is a petition filed under Section 438 Cr. P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.51, dated 01.03.2018 under Sections 131, 132, 134, 135-A of Representation of People Act, 1951 and 1988, registered at Police Station Patran, District Patiala.

Pursuant to the order dated 06.03.2019 passed in connected case viz. CRM-M-42025-2018, the State counsel has placed on record the punishment orders passed by the competent authorities against the police officials for being negligent in performance of their duties at the time of alleged booth capturing. The same is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance to the Order dated 27.09.2018, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel does not dispute the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation.

In view of the above, but without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the Order dated 27.09.2018, passed by this Court, is made absolute.
