On 02.05.2019, following order was passed:-

Archana and Harmanjit Singh, the petitioners before me, claims themselves to be major. They have pleaded that they have got married against the wishes of respondent no.4 and seek protection to their life and liberty. They apprehend danger from respondent no.4. They have placed on record photographs Annexure P-3 evidencing their marriage. The petitioners have submitted a representation dated 30.04.2019, Annexure P-5 to respondent Nos.2 and 3.

Mr. Bhupender Beniwal, AAG, Punjab appearing for the State of Punjab is requested to submit a status report. A copy of the petition be supplied to the State counsel during the course of the day.

In the meantime, respondent no.2 would examine the threat perceptions and if found necessary, interim protection would be provided to them. It is made clear that this order shall not be taken to protect the petitioners from legal action for violation of law, if any, committed by them.

Adjourned to 14.05.2019.

Notice be issued to respondent no.4 also.”

Counsel for the State of Punjab has submitted that the petitioners have given statements to the police that they did not need any police protection.

Neither the petitioners nor their counsel is present.

In view thereof, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and is disposed of as such. However, petitioners would be at liberty to file a fresh petition, if in future there is any threat perceptions.
