The petitioners have approached this Court seeking issuance of directions to respondents No.1 and 2 for protecting their life and liberty as they apprehend threat to the same at the hands of respondents No.3 to 9. While petitioner No.1 Mohd. Vakim is stated to be aged 21 years, petitioner No.2 Shuhaliya is stated to be aged 32 years.

Although, petitioner No.2 is stated to be already married to someone else but both the petitioners are stated to be in a live-in-relationship with each other out of their free will and consent, which is not acceptable to private respondents No.3 to 9, who are relatives of petitioner No.2. It is further stated therein that in fact on 25.4.2019, private respondents No.3 to 9 barged into the residence of the petitioners where they are living together and gave beatings to both the petitioners.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and without commenting anything as regards their relationship, the petition is disposed of with a direction to Superintendent of Police, Palwal, District Palwal (respondent No.2) to look into the matter and to dispose of representation dated 27.4.2019 (Annexure P-3), made by the petitioners, in accordance with law. In case it is found that there is any imminent threat to the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of the private respondents, then it be ensured that no harm is caused to the petitioners.

The aforesaid order shall however, not be construed any expression on merits of the case and shall not confer any immunity upon the petitioners, in case it is found that they have committed any cognizable offence.

A copy of this order along with copy of representation Annexure P-3 be sent to the Superintendent of Police, Palwal, District Palwal (respondent No.2) so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
