Prayer in this petition is for cancellation of bail granted to respondent No.2 in FIR No.724 dated 21.07.2017 under Sections 302, 307, 120-B read with Section 34 IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Sadar Hisar, District Hisar, vide order dated 29.05.2018 passed by this Court in CRM-M-46777-2017.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that subsequent to grant of bail, the petitioner is involved in another FIR No.904 dated 04.09.2018 under Sections 307, 120-B IPC, Section 25 of Arms Act and Section 3 of SC&ST Act, Police Station Sadar Hisar, District Hisar and he has misused the concession of bail granted by this Court.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Vishavjeet Singh

and assisted by learned counsel for respondent No.2, has submitted that during the investigation, the complainant in FIR No.904 namely Kuldeep Singh son of Rajender Singh made a statement that he is an employee of Haryana Police and on the basis of his doubt, he has named five persons, which includes the name of respondent No.2. Later on, in the Panchayat, he has satisfied that the persons, who were nominated by him, as accused are innocent.

A photocopy of the statement dated 03.10.2018 recorded by DSP, Hisar is taken on record.

In view of the above, this petition is dismissed.
