AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner has approached this Court asserting that the petitioner has moved an application under the Right to Information Act, 2005, on 12.03.2019 (Anenxure P-2), to which, no response has been received till date. If that be so, petitioner has a remedy under the Right to Information Act, 2005, which he should avail prior to approaching this Court. Other grievances have also been made by the petitioner but for that, the forum which is available to him is required to be approached. Counsel for the petitioner has further accepted the factum that the petitioner has filed an election petition with regard to his grievance of the elections.

Having considered the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court does not find any justification for interfering in the present writ petition, which has been preferred by the petitioner.

The present petition, therefore, stands dismissed.
