Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that from the year 2012 till 2017, the contribution was deducted from the petitioner keeping in view the revised pay scale, whereas the employee's share was deposited by the respondents on a pre-revised scale due to which, after the retirement of the petitioner on 31.10.2017, petitioner has not been paid the amount for which he was entitled for under the Contributory Provident Fund.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that for the relief, which has been claimed by the petitioner in the present writ petition, petitioner had initially submitted a representation dated 17.12.2018 (Annexure P-5) to the Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Amritsar and as there was no outcome of the same, petitioner served the respondents with a legal notice dated 22.03.2019 (Annexure P-6) and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the

respondents to decide the legal notice by passing a speaking order.

Without going into the merits of the case or expressing any opinion to the entitlement of the petitioner in respect of the relief claimed in the present writ petition or in the legal notice, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to pass an appropriate speaking order on the claim raised by the petitioner in the legal notice dated 22.03.2019 (Annexure P-6) within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

The writ petition stands disposed of.
