Affidavit has been filed by Commissioner of Police, Amritsar City explaining various steps taken after registration of the FIR. It has been pointed out that non-bailable warrants have been got issued from the Court and sincere efforts are being made to arrest the remaining 3 accused.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the prosecuting agency is intentionally not making any sincere endeavour to secure the presence of remaining 3 accused. He further submits that the petitioner is ready to assist the prosecuting agency in securing the arrest.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to Commissioner of Police, Amritsar City to supervise the entire thing. The petitioner would be at liberty to contact Commissioner of Police in this regard. Liberty is also granted to the petitioner to file a fresh petition, if required.
