ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 85, dated 03.07.2018, under Section 22 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Kathgarh, District SBS Nagar.

The allegations against the petitioner are that he was found in possession of 15 injections of Buprenorphine containing 2 ml each which is marginally above the commercial quantity.

The custody certificate shows that the petitioner has also been convicted in other case under the NDPS Act and sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for 10 years

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Balwinder Singh states that two out of 12 prosecution witness have been examined and the matter is now listed on 28.05.2019 for examination of remaining prosecution witnesses. He further states that every effort shall be made to examine the remaining prosecution witnesses.

In view of the statement of learned State counsel, learned counsel for the petitioner contends that she would not press the present petition and a direction be given to the trial Court to conclude the trial expeditiously.

The petition is dismissed as not pressed.

However, the trial Court is directed to conclude the trial expeditiously.
