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**GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J.(Oral)**

The petitioners have approached this Court seeking quashing of FIR No.94 dated 22.11.2017 registered at Police Station Sadar Banga, District SBS Nagar under Sections 323, 324, 325, 326, 148, 149 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 28.9.2018, the parties had been directed to appear before the trial Court so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.

Report of learned Judicial Magistrate 1<sup>st</sup> Class, Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar has been received, wherein it has been reported that statements

of petitioners/accused Kamalpreet Singh, Ramanpreet Singh, Sushil Ganger, Gurinder Singh, Ajay Verma @ Gopi, Tarlochan Singh @ Tota and Surinder Kaur and also of complainant Dharminder Singh have been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter amongst themselves and they have no objection in case the FIR is quashed.

The learned Judicial Magistrate 1<sup>st</sup> Class, Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar has specifically opined that the parties have entered into compromise voluntarily without there being any pressure, coercion or undue influence.

In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (CrL.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.94 dated 22.11.2017 registered at Police Station Sadar Banga, District SBS Nagar under Sections 323, 324, 325, 326, 148, 149 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua petitioners.
