This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No. 97 dated 24.3.2019 registered under Sections 323, 324, 34, 506 IPC (later on offence under Section 326 of IPC added) at PS Rania, District Sirsa.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has argued that an altercation had taken place. As per the allegations nine injuries were made out of which one injury was found to be grievous and to whom that injury was attributed has been arrested. The injuries attributed to the petitioners are simple in nature.

On instructions from SI Jagmail Singh, learned AAG has accepted these factual assertions.

In these circumstances, I do not deem it appropriate to deny

them the concession of bail.

Resultantly, the petition is allowed. In the event of arrest they will be released on bail by the Investigating Officer subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
