Petitioners Anshu and Ajit Kumar have averred that they have married against wishes of respondents No.4 to 9, who are parents, brother and other relatives of petitioner No.1. The petitioners have annexed copies of their Aadhar Cards indicating that they are aged 18 years and 21 years.

The petitioners apprehend threat to their life and liberty at the hands of respondents No.4 to 9 and thus seek issuance of appropriate directions.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Amit Kumar Goyal, Addl.P.P., U.T., Chandigarh, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. A copy of the petition be furnished to the learned counsel representing the State during the course of the day.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, U.T., Chandigarh to look into the representation Annexure P-5 made by petitioners, in accordance with law, immediately upon receipt of certified copy of this order. In case any apprehension of threat to the life and liberty of the petitioners is found, requisite steps be taken immediately, in accordance with law, to protect life and liberty of the petitioners.

It is, however, made clear that this order shall not be taken to be an expression as regards validity of the alleged marriage of the parties.
