Reply by way of affidavit of Gurcharan Singh Dhaliwal, Deputy Superintendent, Central Jail, Patiala has been filed by learned State counsel in Court today and the same is taken on record.

Heard. Petitioner seeks parole for four months on medical grounds. He also seeks quashing of the order dated 11.04.2019(Annexure P-4) filed by him whereby parole on medical grounds has been disallowed by Superintendent, Central Jail, Patiala stating therein that the superintendent is not competent to pass such order. Reply of the state is obtained regarding the medical condition of the petitioner. In the report annexed with the reply it is stated that petitioner is diagnosed case of carcinoma(Cancer) prostate and CA urinary bladder stage IV. Earlier surgery was done in the year 2018 and both his testes were removed. He was to be taken to PGIMER, Chandigarh on 26.04.2019 but could not be sent there due to administrative reasons. He is supposed to go to Radiotherapy unit for review and needful

treatment. Considering the medical condition of the petitioner as stated in the report of the jail authorities I am of the view that petitioner needs to be released on parole on medical grounds to get himself treated for carcinoma(Cancer) prostate. As such his application is allowed. He is ordered to be released on parole for a period of two months subject to furnishing sufficient surety to the satisfaction of the District Magistrate concerned.

Petition is accordingly allowed.
