Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from Mr. Mandeep Singh, Senior Assistant, Punjab Civil Secretariat, Establishment-I, General Administration, Punjab submits that pension, gratuity and leave encashment have been revised and the matter is in the process for releasing the monetary benefits. It is stated that the amount shall be credited in the account of the petitioners within six weeks from today.

In view of the above, the contempt petition is disposed of. However, the respondents are directed to supply details of the amount found due to the petitioners within six weeks from today.
