The present contempt petition has been filed alleging wilful disobedience of the order dated 23.10.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No. 27174 of 2018. The operative part of the said order is reproduced below:

“In view of above, present writ petition stands disposed of with the directions to the respondents to look into and take the required action on representation dated 5.7.2018 (Annexure P16), made by the petitioner, in the light of judgment rendered by this Court in *Pritpal Kaur's case* (supra) expeditiously and preferably within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.”

Learned counsel for the State submits that in compliance of the order of this court, order dated 18.7.2019 has been passed. Copy thereof

has been given to counsel for the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that no cause of action survives. However, she states that in case of any grievance, the petitioner be granted liberty to avail the remedies as are available in accordance with law.

The contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous with liberty as prayed for.
