AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 26.11.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No.21888 of 2016.

The operational part of the order is reproduced below:-

“Let a representation in this regard be made to the respondents within a period of four weeks from today and in case any such representation is made, the respondents shall pass a speaking order within a period of two months thereafter. If after passing of the order, the petitioner is found entitled for any monetary benefits, the same shall also be released within a period of two months.”

The respondent has filed reply by way of affidavit of Amarpal Singh, Managing Director, PUNSUP, Chandigarh today in

the Court, same is taken on record. Copy of reply is handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner.

It has been stated that order has been passed and due amount has been transferred to account of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, in absence of any instructions, is not able to rebut the statement.

In view of statement made, the contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous, with liberty to the petitioner to revive the same if there is discrepancy in statement made today.

The rule issued against the respondent is discharged.
