Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.179 dated 21.08.2018 under Sections 498-A/406 IPC registered at Police Station Jandiala, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to order dated 27.02.2019 of this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sukhdev Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid fact. He submits that recovery of Alto car and other dowry articles including 2.83 Tola gold articles have been recovered.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation and his custody is no more required, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 01.10.2018 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when directed by the investigating agency and shall abide by the terms and conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
