Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in FIR No.461 dated 11.09.2018 under Sections 34, 354-A, 377, 406, 498-A, 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Thanesar, District Kurukshetra.

Vide order dated 22.11.2018, the parties were directed to appear before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court on 28.11.2018.

Pursuant thereto, the parties have appeared before the Mediation Centre and a report has been received that mediation is

successful and the settlement/agreement dated 29.03.2019 between the parties has been reduced into writing.

Learned counsel for the complainant does not dispute the very factum of settlement/agreement dated 29.03.2019.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the matter has been compromised between the parties before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 01.10.2018 is made absolute.

The parties shall adhere to the terms & conditions of the settlement/agreement dated 29.03.2019 in letter and spirit.
