Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing the order dated 04.06.2016 (Annexure P-2) passed by learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Patti, whereby the petitioner has been declared as Proclaimed Offender in case FIR No.53 dated 29.10.2015 registered under Sections 498-A, 406, 120-B IPC at Police Station Khalra, District Tarn Taran.

Power of attorney filed on behalf of respondent No.2 in Court today, is taken on record.

This Court vide order dated 28.09.2018 while issuing notice of motion in the case has stayed the arrest of the petitioner and has further directed him to join the proceedings before the trial Court on or before

07.01.2019. On his doing so, the trial Court was directed to release the petitioner on interim bail subject to his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to its satisfaction.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has produced certified copy of order dated 27.11.2018 passed by learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Patti which shows that pursuant to the order dated 28.09.2018 passed by this Court, the petitioner appeared before the trial Court and has been admitted on interim bail on his furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount.

The copy of order dated 27.11.2018 so produced by learned counsel for the petitioner shall form part of the record.

In view of above, the order dated 28.09.2018 passed by this Court is made absolute

Disposed of.

However, the petitioner shall continue to appear before the trial Court on each and every date of hearing unless his personal appearance is exempted.
