The present contempt petition is filed pleading wilful disobedience of order of this Court dated 1.6.2018. The petitioner filed a writ petition seeking direction to the respondents for payment of consequential service benefits by implementing promotion order dated 24.6.2016 retrospectively w.e.f. 26.11.1985. It was averred that there was discrimination qua the petitioner vis-a-vis his junior. The writ petition was allowed on 1.6.2018 in terms of decision of this Court in CWP No. 1839 of 2013 titled as **Avtar Singh Versus The Chief Secretary, Govt. of Punjab and others.**

The present petition is filed pleading that the needful has not been done.

Learned counsel for respondents relied upon order dated 27.6.2016 annexed with reply dated 3.9.2019 filed on behalf of respondent No.2.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the said order has been passed pursuant to order of this court passed in CWP No. 6454 of 2016 and not in compliance with CWP No. 4716 of 2017.

Learned State counsel submits that a fresh order for compliance (if already not complied with) of decision of CWP No. 4716 of 2017 would be passed within six weeks from today.

In view of above, the contempt petition is disposed of. The petitioner would be at liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law in case aggrieved of the order passed.
