Present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short 'Cr. P.C.') for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, in FIR No.90 dated 02.09.2018, under Section 406 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short 'IPC'), registered at Police Station Bhadaur, District Barnala.

On 01.10.2018, while issuing notice of motion, this Court has passed the following order:-

“Notice of motion for 19.11.2018.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the Arresting/Investigating Officer within seven days. On doing so, he shall be released on interim bail, subject to his furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, he shall abide by the terms and conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. failing which he shall lose the benefit of interim bail allowed to him.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner has apprised this Court that in terms of order dated 01.10.2018, the petitioner has joined the

proceedings before the learned trial Court and has also furnished necessary bail/surety bonds.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from the police official who is present in the Court to assist him, has acknowledged the above fact of joining proceedings.

In view of the above, the interim order dated 01.10.2018, is hereby made absolute, subject to the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr. P.C.

Petition stands disposed off, accordingly.

However, it is made clear that the petitioner shall fully co-operate with the Investigating Officer as and when called for further investigation.

The above observations may not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
