Learned counsel contends that a spelling mistake occurred in the petitioner's mother name during forwarding of list of candidates by the respondent-school to the Central Board of Secondary Education and on the same being pointed out by the petitioner, the respondent-school vide communication Annexure P-8 requested the Regional Office, Central Board of Secondary Education to correct the petitioner's mother name in the record of the Board but till date no action has been taken by the authorities in respect thereto. Learned counsel states that in the circumstances, the petitioner would be satisfied if the writ petition is disposed of by granting liberty to the petitioner to file a detailed representation in respect of the relief claimed along with documents and the Central Board of Secondary Education is directed to consider and decide the representation on receipt in accordance with law by taking into account communication Annexure P-8.

2. In view of the innocuous nature of the prayer, the writ petition is disposed of by granting liberty to the petitioner to make a detailed

representation to the Central Board of Secondary Education for correction of his mother's name. On receipt of representation by the Regional Office (Correction Cell), Central Board of Secondary Education, respondent No.3, would consider and decide the same in accordance with law as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of two months from the date of receipt of such representation while taking into account the communication Annexure P-8.

3. Writ petition disposed of in the aforementioned terms.
