Prayer made in the petition is for quashing of order dated 28.2.2019 passed by the Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gurdaspur arising out of FIR No.69 dated 13.6.2018 under Section 420 IPC registered at Police Station Sadar, Gurdaspur whereby the petitioner has been declared a proclaimed offender.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the order dated 6.5.2019, the petitioner has appeared before the Investigating Officer and she has been released on interim bail.

Counsel for the petitioner has further submitted that on the same day, the petitioner was arrested in some other FIR pertaining to the same Police Station and taken into judicial custody.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Ram Lal submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation while she was taken into custody and no more required.

In view of the same, the petition is allowed; order dated 28.2.2019 passed by the trial Court declaring the petitioner a proclaimed offender is set aside and the order dated 6.5.2019 passed by this Court, is made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of, accordingly.
