The present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No. 109, dated 19.6.2018, registered at Police Station PAU, District Ludhiana, under Sections 336, 341, 294 and 506 IPC and proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 1.10.2018 the parties had been directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court so as to get the statements recorded.

Report of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Ludhiana has been received to the effect that statement of complainant-Sanchit Gupta and also of petitioner/accused Gurpreet Singh have been recorded to the effect that they have entered into a compromise with the intervention of

respectables. The complainant has specifically stated that he has no objection if the FIR in the present case is quashed. Learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Ludhiana opined that the compromise arrived between the parties is genuine, voluntary and without any coercion or undue influence.

In view of the aforesaid report and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the petition is allowed and FIR No. 109, dated 19.6.2018, registered at Police Station PAU, District Ludhiana, under Sections 336, 341, 294 and 506 IPC and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioner.
