MANOJ BAJAJ, J.

By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in FIR No.19 dated 27.03.2018 registered under Section 306 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Joga, District Mansa.

On 10.10.2018, this Court had passed the following order:-

*“Adjourned to 18.01.2019.
Meanwhile, in the event of arrest of the petitioner, she shall be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when directed by the investigating agency and shall abide by the terms and conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”*

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in pursuance of the order dated 10.10.2018, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Pala Singh submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and she is not

required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 10.10.2018, is made absolute.

The petition stands allowed.
