Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.97 dated 17.08.2018 under Sections 498-A, 323, 506, 376, 511, 377 IPC registered at Police Station Bapoli, District Panipat.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from the IO, submits that during the course of investigation, petitioner no.3-Ritu has been found innocent whereas petitioners no.1 and 2 have joined investigation and their custodial interrogation is no more required. He further submits that during investigation, offence under Sections 376 and 511 IPC have been deleted.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the fact that the petitioners have joined investigation and their custodial interrogation is no more required, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 01.10.2018 is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall join the investigation as and when directed by the investigating agency and shall abide by the terms and conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
