Learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Dhanwant Singh, PS Moti Nagar, District Ludhiana, submits that petitioner no. 1-Savitri Devi @ Gudia has since joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation and nothing is to be recovered from her and that he has no objection if the interim order is made absolute.

In the light of the statement made by learned State counsel, the interim bail granted to petitioner no. 1-Savitri Devi @ Gudia vide order dated 15.10.2018 is made absolute till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). Thereafter, petitioner no. 1-Savitri Devi @ Gudia will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

With these observations, the present petition stands disposed off.
