Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to harass them at the instance of respondent Nos.4 and 5.

The petitioners have got married against the wishes of their parents. They are stated to be major. In support of her proof of age petitioner No.1 has placed on record a copy of Aadhar Card (Annexure P-1) wherein her date of birth is mentioned as 24.04.1999 whereas petitioner No.2 has also placed on record a copy of Aadhar Card (Annexure P-2) depicting his date of birth as 02.11.1993. They have also moved a representation before the Superintendent of Police, Yamuna Nagar (Annexure P-5) for protection of their life and liberty.

Notice of motion only qua respondents No.1 to 3.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Gaurav Bansal, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State.

Counsel for the petitioners undertakes to supply a copy of the petition to the learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Without adverting to the merits of the controversy and certifying the marriage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Yamuna Nagar to take appropriate action on the said representation (Annexure P-5).

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
