Prayer in the present petition is seeking direction to the official respondents No.2 to 4 to submit final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.5, dated 08.02.2018 under Sections 420, 120-B of IPC, at Police Station Talwara, District Hoshiarpur.

Learned State counsel has filed status report by way of affidavit of Sub-Inspector Surjit Singh, SHO Police Station Talwara, District Hoshiarpur, on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4 in Court today and the same is taken on record.

It is stated in the reply that the police has conducted investigation in the case and is going to file challan against some of the accused, who have been found involved in the crime by the police.

During the course of arguments, learned State counsel, being instructed by ASI Om Parkash, submits that challan was in fact prepared against one person and sent to District Attorney for legal advice. However, the District Attorney has raised certain objections. The police would address the objections and file the challan within a period of two weeks

from today.

In view of the above facts, this Court does not deem it appropriate to keep the petition pending. Hence, the same is disposed of with a direction that the SHO, Police Station Talwara, District Hoshiarpur shall file the challan before the Court within a period of four weeks from today, without fail.
