Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.47 dated 01.04.2019 under Section 420 IPC and Sections 61/1/14 of Punjab Excise Act,1914, registered at Police Station Garhshankar, District Hoshiarpur.

The operative part of the order dated 06.05.2019, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per allegations in the FIR, on receiving a secret information that the petitioner is present in the forest area of Gram Panchayat Rampur along with heavy quantity of liquor meant for sale in the outer State and if a raid is conducted, he can be nabbed. It is further stated in the FIR that when the police party reached at the spot, on seeing them, the petitioner ran away from the spot and the police effected recovery of 10 boxes of liquor having 12 bottles each, meant for sale in Arunachal Pradesh. Learned counsel further submits that recovery has already been effected and the petitioner is ready to join the investigation and he is not involved in any other case.

Notice of motion for 29.07.2019.”

The Investigating Officer, who is present in Court, submits that in pursuance to the order dated 06.05.2019, the petitioner has already joined the investigation and he is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 06.05.2019, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
