On 03.05.2019, following order was passed:-

*“Lovedeep Kaur and Amandeep, the petitioners before me, claim themselves to be major. They have pleaded that they have got married against the wishes of respondent Nos.4 to 7 and seek protection to their life and liberty. They apprehend danger from respondent Nos.4 to 7. They have placed on record photographs Annexure P-3 evidencing their marriage. The petitioners have submitted a representation dated 01.05.2019, Annexure P-4 to respondent No.2.*

*Mr. Bhupender Beniwal, AAG, Punjab, appearing for the State of Punjab is requested to submit a status report. A copy of the petition be supplied to the State counsel during the course of the day.*

*In the meantime, respondent No.2 would examine the threat perceptions and if found necessary, interim protection would be provided to them. It is made clear that this order shall not be taken to protect the petitioners from legal action for violation of law, if any, committed by them.*

*Adjourned to 15.05.2019.*

*Notice be also issued to respondents No.4 to 7 for the date fixed.”*

On 15.05.2019, neither the petitioners nor their counsel were present and following order was passed:-

*“Learned counsel appearing for the State of Punjab, on instructions from Rajinder Singh, SI, has submitted that respondent no.4 has jointed the enquiry and he has stated that he would not interfere in the married life of the petitioners. However, he stated that whereabouts of the petitioners are not known.*

*Since, neither the petitioners nor their counsel is present and the process fee for service of respondents no.4 to 7 have not been filed, therefore, in the interest of justice, adjourned to 30.05.2019.*

*Process fee be filed within a period of 3 days. If process fee is deposited, the office would issue notice to respondents no.4 to 7, for the date fixed.”*

Learned counsel for the State on instructions from ASI Rajesh Kumar, has submitted that the police has recorded statement of respondent Nos.4 and 5 who have accepted the marriage between the petitioners and have undertaken not to interfere in their married life.

In view thereof, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to file fresh one if there is any fresh threat to their life and liberty.
