In the present writ petition, the grievance which is being raised by the petitioner is that he performed the duties of Principal, while he was in service, though on current duty charge but keeping in view the duties performed by him at the higher post, he is entitled for the grant of additional increment in terms of the order passed by this Court in CWP No. 9125 of 2014, titled as ***Sukhraj Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another (Annexure P-8)***, and also the pensionary benefits in terms of the order passed by the Division Bench in LPA No. 37 of 2017, decided on 25.09.2018 (Annexure P-9).

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that for the relief, which has been claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioner has served the respondents with a legal notice dated 30.09.2018 (Annexure P-10) and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the legal notice by passing a speaking order.

Without going into the merits of the case or expressing any opinion to the entitlement of the petitioner in respect of the relief claimed in the present writ petition or in the legal notice, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to pass an appropriate speaking order on the claim raised by the petitioner in the legal notice dated 30.09.2018 (Annexure P-10) within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

The writ petition stands disposed of.
