As per the report submitted by the trial Court, apart from the respondent/complainant, some more persons namely Sukhmeet Singh, Navjot, Ram Parkash and Mohit Hooda, have also recorded their statements under Section 161 Cr.P.C. during the investigation and thus, the trial Court has recorded a finding that the involvement of the present accused as well as other Directors of M/s Career Overseas Immigration Consultants, has been found regarding other victims as well.

In view of the same, it cannot be said that the compromise arrived at between the petitioner and respondent is a complete compromise and accordingly, the present petition is dismissed with liberty to the petitioner to file afresh petition if complete compromise is arrived at between the parties.
