INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.36 dated 24.02.2019, registered at Police Station Division A, District Police Commissionerate Amritsar, under Sections 365, 380, 427, 447, 457, 511, 506, 508, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959 (added later on).

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

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From the record, I find that the present petitioner has not been named in the FIR. The main allegations, as per the FIR, are against co-accused, namely, Rajiv Khokhar @ Billu, who has already been granted the benefit of anticipatory bail by this Court, as argued by learned counsel for the petitioner.

The offences are triable by the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class. The petitioner is in custody since 28.02.2019. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of case may take a long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹40,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
