The petitioner has approached this Court seeking issuance of direction to respondent No.2 to initiate appropriate investigation and to register case against respondent No.4 for having amassed wealth beyond his known sources of income.

It appears that the matter has been inquired into by Joint Director, Agriculture, upon having received a letter from the Office of Chief Director Vigilance Bureau, Punjab, and it had been found that due to non-availability of proof regarding acquiring property beyond the known sources of income, the complaint be filed.

At this stage, this Court does not find any ground for issuing any direction, more particularly at the instance of Baljit Singh who cannot be said to be an aggrieved person so as to have any *locus standi*. It is however, clarified that this order is not to be treated as a bar in any manner for Vigilance Bureau to look into the matter in case it is brought to its notice that respondent No.4 has amassed wealth beyond his known sources of income.

The petition is disposed off accordingly.
