The present petition has been filed by the petitioners under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of a direction to the official respondents No.1 to 3 for protection of their life and liberty at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 6, as they have married against the wishes of private respondents.

Learned State counsel has filed the status report by way of affidavit of Arun Sharma, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Attari, Amritsar (Rural) annexing the copies of statements of respondents No.4 to 6. Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Baljinder Singh has apprised the Court that the statements of respondents

No.4 to 6 have been recorded, wherein they have expressed no objection to the alleged marriage between the petitioners. The status report alongwith statements of respondents No.4 to 6 are taken on record.

In view of the statements of respondents No.4 to 6, learned counsel for the petitioners stated that the alleged threat has vanished, and therefore, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
