ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 321, dated 29.10.2018, under Sections 399 and 402 IPC, registered at Police Station Sector-11, Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner in the FIR are that the petitioner and four others were planning to rob petrol pump and they were apprehended. He further contends that the petitioner has not done any overt act in furtherance of the alleged plot to rob the petrol pump. He also contends that the petitioner is 21 years of age and is not involved in any other case.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Jagroop Singh states that 04 out of 12 prosecution witnesses have been examined.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the petitioner is in custody for over 07 months and conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
