Prayer in this petition is for issuance of directions to official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners, as petitioner Nos. 1 and 2 are senior citizens, from the hands of respondent No. 4, daughter-in-law of petitioner Nos. 1 and 2, as she is putting pressure on them to transfer the land.

It is further stated in the petition that respondent No. 3, who is an Assistant Sub Inspector at the police station concerned, is also putting pressure on petitioners and is supporting respondent No. 4.

Reply, filed by way of affidavit of DSP, Zira, District Ferozepur, is on record. As per reply, petitioner No. 1 had moved an application before the DGP, Punjab and had also given complaints before the police authorities that respondent No. 4 is his daughter-in-law and petitioner No. 3 is the husband of respondent No. 4 and she, along with respondent No. 3, is threatening the petitioners that she will grab their property. It is further stated

in reply that the said complaint was marked to to SHO of the police station concerned for conducting an inquiry and during the said inquiry, the allegations were found to be false. It is further stated that later on, another application was given before the SSP, Ferozepur, in which, an inquiry was conducted by the DSP, Zira and the allegations levelled against respondent No. 3 and others were found to be false and the said inquiry report was approved by SSP, Ferozepur and was sent to the Punjab Human Rights Commission, Chandigarh for further action.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Dilbagh Singh, submits that the possession of the house was delivered to the petitioners from respondent No. 4 in accordance with law.

In view of the above, no further action is called for in the present petition and the same is disposed of accordingly.

However, liberty is granted to the petitioners to approach SSP, Ferozepur in case they still feel any threat to their life and liberty by way of moving an appropriate application and the said application shall be decided by SSP, Ferozepur in accordance with law.
