Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.63 dated 20.03.2019 under Sections 15/25/29 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Lehra, District Sangrur.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 06.05.2019: -

“...Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that as per the FIR registered on the basis of a secret information, the brother-in-law of the petitioner namely Jasvir Singh @ Ladi along with one Sukhchain Singh @ Chaina and Gurpreet Singh @ Guri were arrested and on search of a car bearing registration No.PB-13-BC-0572, 40 Kgs of poppy husk was recovered. It is further

argued that the petitioner was neither present at the spot nor any recovery was effected from him. It is also submitted that the petitioner has been implicated in the case only because of the fact that recovery has been effected from his brother-in-law – Jasvir Singh @ Ladi. It is further argued that the petitioner is not involved in any other case....”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Joginder Singh, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 06.05.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
