The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in Criminal Complaint No.892 of 2016 dated 04.06.2016 titled as 'Gulab Kanwar @ Bhawna versus Sachin Narayan' under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act pending in the Court of Shri Puneet Limbha, JMIC, Hissar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the criminal complaint against the petitioner is the outcome of a matrimonial dispute between him and his wife, who is the complainant. The petitioner had earlier been appearing before the Trial Court but he could not appear before the Trial Court on 11.03.2019 due to ill health and had preferred an application for exemption from appearance. He also contends that efforts are being made by the petitioner to settle the dispute. He undertakes that the petitioner shall henceforth appear before the Trial Court on each and every date of hearing and would not absent himself except with the prior permission of the Court.

This Court, by the order dated 06.05.2019, had directed the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court and on his doing so, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner had surrendered before the trial Court and was released on ad interim bail. He also contends that the petitioner is regularly appearing before the trial Court.

In view of the above, interim order dated 06.05.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall appear regularly before the trial Court and shall not absent himself without the prior permission of the trial Court.

The petition stands disposed of.
