The Regional Director, Employees State Insurance Corporation vide notice dated 28.02.2019 had invited Expression of Interest for Empanelment of Hospitals for Super Specialty Treatment and Super Specialty Investigation for its beneficiaries in the State of Punjab and Union Territory, Chandigarh. Petitioner No. 1, a unit of petitioner No. 2, in response thereto submitted its Expression of Interest only for Super Specialty Treatment. The limited grievance the petitioner has is that the respondent-authorities have declined its claim as it failed to mention anything as regards Super Specialty Investigation upon a portion of a technical bid.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that since petitioner No. 1 had only applied for Super Specialty Treatment, therefore, it was not under an obligation to express anything as regards Super Specialty Investigation and, thus, the reasons for rejecting the bid/claim of petitioner No. 1 is

erroneous. Not just that, the authorities have also been served with repeated representations in this regard, but to no avail.

3. Having argued the matter at some length, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that let this petition be disposed of, at this stage, only with a direction to the respondent-authorities to consider and deal with the representations submitted by petitioner No. 1 and pass appropriate orders.

4. In the wake of the above, we dispose of this petition, without commenting upon the merits of the case, only with a direction to the respondents that if indeed the representations, referred to above, are pending consideration, the authorities shall pass appropriate orders in accordance with law after affording an opportunity of hearing to all the stake holders within a period of two weeks from the receipt of certified copy of this order.
