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Station Women, Sector 16, Faridabad, District Faridabad.

As per FIR, the prosecutrix was kidnapped and she was taken to a hotel where she was subjected to rape by Rahul and Asif. She was confined there whole night and during this period both of them repeatedly and forcibly committed rape upon her.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the deposition of the prosecutrix is not reliable and does not inspire confidence.

Heard.

A bare perusal of the deposition of the prosecutrix transpires that the same is consistent. However, on a bare perusal of the available record, nothing has been expressed therein, as submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner.

Hence, finding no ground to grant the benefit of regular bail to the petitioner, the instant petition stands dismissed.
