TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J.(ORAL)

Petitioners have filed the instant writ petition raising a grievance that the respondent-Punjab State Power Corporation Limited, is in the process of shifting of high voltage wires from one residential area to another location which is asserted to be even more thickly populated in comparison.

Counsel submits that he would be satisfied if the writ petition was to be disposed of with a direction to the concerned Superintending Engineer, to look into the matter against the backdrop of a representation that has already been made.

In view of the above and without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the writ petition at the very threshold with a direction to respondent No.3 i.e. Superintending Engineer, Punjab State Power Corporation Limited, Amritsar, to examine the issue in the light of representation dated 11.02.2019 (Annexure P-3) and to thereafter take steps as he may deem fit and appropriate.
