Present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.26 dated 21.02.2018 under Sections 34, 377, 506, 201 IPC, Section 67-I of Information Technology Act and Section 3/2 of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989, registered at Police Station Loharu, Distirct Bhiwani.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the case. The petitioner is in custody since 21.02.2018 and co-accused Govind has already been admitted to bail as per order passed by this Court on 28.08.2018 in CRM-M-19885 of 2018 and decision of the case still to take some more time, so he be released on bail.

Learned counsel for the petitioner also contended that the compromise has been effected between the parties and written compromise

Annexure P-2 is on the file.

Learned State counsel while opposing the bail application contended that out of 15 witnesses in the final report, 14 witnesses have already been examined and trial is at the fag end.

Having considered the submission made by learned counsel for the parties and the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 21.02.2018; co-accused Govind has already been admitted to bail as per order passed by this Court on 28.08.2018 in CRM-M-19885 of 2018; the trial of the case still to take some more time and no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner behind the bar any more, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be admitted on regular bail on furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of concerned learned trial Judge/ Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate.
