The present contempt petition has been filed alleging wilful disobedience of the order dated 29.1.2019 passed by this Court in CRM-M 3940 of 2019. The operative part of the said order is reproduced below:

“After hearing learned counsel for both the sides, the present petition stands disposed off with a direction to the official respondents No. 1 to 6-State to consider and decide representation of the petitioner (Annexure P-2) within the framework of law, expeditiously, by passing a speaking order. However, this order shall not come in way for taking any action by the State against anyone found guilty whosoever in commission of any offence.”

Reply by way of affidavit of Sukhchain Singh Gill, IPS,

Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana has been filed. It has been pleaded that in compliance of the order of this court, order (Annexure R-1) has been passed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that no cause of action survives. However, he states that in case of any grievance, the petitioner be granted liberty to avail the remedies as are available in accordance with law.

The contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous with liberty as prayed for.
