Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail in FIR No.184 dated 29.08.2018 under Sections 452, 323, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Maur, District Bathinda.

Learned counsel for the petitioners, at the very outset, seeks permission to withdraw the present petition qua petitioner No.1 Gurpreet Singh @ Gokal.

Ordered accordingly.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that serious injury is attributed to co-accused Gurpreet Singh @ Gokal and the allegations against petitioner No.2 Talwinder Singh @ Bhinder Singh are that he gave a wood

blow to the complainant. It is further submitted that the petitioner is in custody for the last 03 months and 03 days; investigation is complete; challan stands presented and it will take some time in conclusion of the trial. Learned counsel further submits that it is a case of version and cross-version and even co-accused Gupreet Singh @ Gokal has suffered injury in the cross-version case.

Learned State counsel, on the basis of custody certificate dated 23.05.2019 filed in the Court today, has not disputed the factual position.

Learned counsel for the complainant has however argued that there are serious allegations against the petitioners.

Without commenting anything on merits of the case, considering the aforesaid arguments raised by learned counsel for the parties, this petition is allowed and petitioner No.2 Talwinder Singh @ Bhinder Singh is directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing his bail/surety bond to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.

Petition is disposed of.
