The present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No. 494 dated 20.08.2018 registered under Section 307 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station City Bahadurgarh, District Jhajjar, on the basis of compromise dated 25.08.2018 (Annexure P-5).

Pursuant to order dated 15.11.2018, Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Bahadurgarh, has submitted her report wherein on the basis of statements of the petitioner and respondent No. 2, it has been reported that the compromise between the parties is genuine and has been arrived at without any threat or coercion. Moreover, it is no injury case and the petitioner had allegedly fired from his pistol which hit on the wall of the hospital.

In view of the above and the fact that the petitioner and respondent No. 2 has amicably settled their grievance against each other and have decided to live with peace and tranquility, the instant petition is allowed and the FIR No. 494 dated

20.08.2018 registered under Section 307 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station City Bahadurgarh, District Jhajjar, and all the consequential proceedings having arisen therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioner.
