The petitioner, a widow of a police official prays for conduct of fair and impartial investigation through some independent agency. She earlier also filed a petition and vide order dated 01.09.2016 in CRM-M-30775 of 2016, directions were issued to respondent No.2 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala to pass a speaking order. The Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala has passed a speaking order on the basis of an enquiry conducted through Deputy Superintendent of Police. In these circumstances, although, it is very hard, however, keeping in view the fact that the department is alleging that husband of the petitioner had slipped from the stairs and received survival and spine injuries and no post-mortem of the body of the husband of the petitioner was conducted, no further orders in the present petition are justified.

Keeping in view the aforesaid fact, the petitioner is relegated to the alternative remedy.

Hence, the petition is disposed of.
