FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Rakesh Kumar in case registered by way of FIR No.460 dated 07.08.2018 at Police Station City Bahadurgarh under Sections 323, 377, 498-A, 506, 34 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner Mr. Munfaid Khan, Advocate submits that in compliance of the orders of interim bail dated 05.10.2018 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined investigations which is not controverted by learned State counsel on instructions from SI (Ms.) Neelam, Police Station city Bahadurgarh who submits that the petitioner is no longer required for further investigation and nothing is to be recovered from him and that she has no objection if the interim order is made absolute.

Though on behalf of the complainant, Mr. Sandeep Kotla, Advocate has sought to oppose the bail, however, in view of the stand of the State and in the light of orders passed earlier, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 05.10.2018 is made absolute on the same terms and conditions. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan) and thereafter, he will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
